We have also found that the kids have connected and feel at home. At the same time we have discovered that life is very hard here and many of

the things about ourselves that

we would like to believe do not exist have surfaced and proclaimed themselves. As a result we have grown in many ways (and been humbled in many ways).

Through all of this we have decided to return to PNG. This is exciting in many ways but also very hard on friends and family. It is not an issue of whether we like Gresham or PNG better (in many ways we like Gresham more), but it is simply a matter of where we feel God is calling us to at this point and where we can best be used by him.
