Alyssa hesitated to finish the sentence but then went on, “. . . to be a missionary kid.” I (Cathy) asked her why and she responded, “Well, we get to go to places no one else goes, but I mostly like it because we get to be a

part of bringing God’s Word to people who don’t have it.”

What a joy to hear our daughter share in the vision God has given us! When we began this journey five years ago, Alyssa wasn’t sure what to make of it. When the time came closer to actually leaving, she began asking more questions. Finally she said, “Now tell me again how you *know* that God wants you to go to Papua New Guinea.” We told her all the stories again about how God led us to where we were and then she replied, “OK. I can see that God is calling *you* to Papua New Guinea, but I don’t think God is calling *me* to Papua New Guinea.”

The first time we went out, she came along for the ride, but this time she has a passion of her own! We all share her passion and are excited to get back to the work God has for us there.

What will it take?

For us to return to Papua New Guinea we’re required to be at 100% of our monthly budget. This means that we need to have enough partners who have agreed to partner and contribute to our Wycliffe ministry monthly, that we can expect to have our monthly needs financially covered.

We’re currently at **84%** of said **monthly** budget. Please consider joining our team with a monthly commitment, or if you’re already part of our financial team, *consider increasing* your gift or even “just” *telling others!*

We also have a rather large **one-time** expense that includes our return airline tickets as well as the remainder of the medical expenses we have accrued while being home. In total we need about \$12,000. We currently have about **25%** of this funded. (If you would prefer to give a one-time gift rather than a monthly commitment, this is where that money will go.)



We know that God is the one who provides for our needs and we trust him to build this team. Thank you for standing with us in prayer as he does so.
